

Medical Universiade 2016

Date: 25.02.2016 - 28.02.2016

Place: Information is in the official programme.

Starting time: Information is in the official programme.

Duration: About 2 hours per vol.

Team division: Every student who is a participant (passive or active) in IBC-Sofia 2016 can also participate in “The Medical Universiade 2016”. Participants enter the competition as a part of team composed of 5 students. Teams are formed as it follows:

1. Participants can enter the competition as a part of a team of their choice ONLY IF the team is composed of: 1 first year student, 2 students in their second or third year and 2 students in their 4-6 year.
2. All other participants who do not register as a part of a team with the mentioned above model will be assigned to a random team with the mentioned above structure (if possible).

Structure: The Medical Universiade 2016 consists of two main stages:

STAGE 1: In the first stage of The Medical Universiade are tested the individual knowledge, quick thinking and practical capability of all members of a certain team. The stage consists of five checkpoints: Anatomy, Physiology, Histology, Biochemistry and an Overview Test. The Anatomy, Physiology and Histology checkpoints are practical tasks, whereas the Biochemistry and Test checkpoints are writing exams. On every checkpoint the members have about five minutes to complete the task.

The team enters the examination room, every member picks a checkpoint of his choice and when all members are ready – the clock starts ticking. On every five minute mark the students stand up and move to the checkpoint to their right. The stage is completed when every member passes through all checkpoints (or roughly 25 minutes per team). Every participant is awarded 1 to 10 points on every checkpoint according to how well he managed to complete the task in that checkpoint. The sum of the points of a single member affect not only his own result but also the result of the team. On the basis of the results of all participants in this stage a winner of the individual section of The Medical Universiade will be announced.

STAGE 2: In stage two of The Medical Universiade team members must work together to deal with 3 clinical cases. Participants must have at least general knowledge of all major subjects included in the academic education, if they want to finish this stage. Finishing faster than other teams brings your team more points, so in this stage it is not only about giving the correct answers, but also giving them fast. The winner in the group section of the Universiade is the team with the biggest point sum, which is formed by the points of every member from STAGE 1 plus the earned points in STAGE 2.
